

## Firmware Upgrade Instructions

**Important note:** Once you have upgraded your firmware, you will no longer be able to run your current version of BaseStation. Once you have upgraded your firmware you must then install the latest version of BaseStation (1.1.0.64 or later) which is available as a free download from our website and is installed the same as any standard BaseStation upgrade (download setup.exe, run it, and then follow all standard defaults).



**Follow steps 1 to 8 to upgrade your firmware.**

### **Step 1**

Download the v301 firmware upgrade file (setup.exe) from the Downloads section of the Kinetic website.

### **Step 2**

Before performing the upload, we need to make sure that the SBS-1 will be able to receive the upload.

- Please disconnect the aerial from the SBS-1.
- If BaseStation is running then shut it down.
- Please ensure that the SBS-1 is connected to your PC.

### **Step 3**

Run the setup.exe file that you have just downloaded.

### **Step 4**

Click Next.

### **Step 5**

Click Install.

### **Step 6**

Click Finish.

The SBS1 Windows Firmware Uploader will then run.

*Note: If for any reason you need to run the uploader again, later (if you had to abort the upgrading, for example) you can, by clicking on its Start Menu icon (Programs -> Kinetic Avionic Products -> SBS-1 Firmware Upgrader).*

### **Step 7**

Click Yes.

The firmware upgrade will then take place in a separate window. When it is complete, click any key to close that window and then close the SDBS1 Windows Firmware Uploader.

**Note:** The upgrade process (the one that runs in a separate window) will inform you of the success of the process. Make sure that it has informed you that the upgrade was successful before continuing.

### ***Step 8***

You should now install the BaseStation update. Remember to reattach your aerial to your SBS-1.
